Chemistry GCSE

What do you study?

GCSE Chemistry covers 10 topics and is assessed over 2 papers. Both papers include multiple choice, short answer and extended answer questions with 5 topics on each paper. There is no coursework element but the importance of practical work in Chemistry is acknowledged and assessed through 8 **Required Practicals** which students experience throughout the course. Questions on these are examined within the relevant topics on each paper.

Topics:

- 1. Atomic structure and the periodic table
- 2. Bonding, structure, and the properties of matter
- 3. Quantitative chemistry
- 4. Chemical changes
- 5. Energy changes
- 6. The rate and extent of chemical change
- 7. Organic chemistry
- 8. Chemical analysis
- 9. Chemistry of the atmosphere
- 10. Using resources

How is the course assessed?

Paper 1 – 1h 45 (100 marks, topics 1-5) Paper 2 – 1h 45 (100 marks, topics 6-10)
